- (1) List of candidates finally selected for the above courses after counseling will be announced on the following dates:
 - (i) MSc AgBT: 16 June 2016 at 4 pm
 - (ii) MSc ARD: 17 June 2016 at 4 pm
- (2) The list will be put up on the Faculty Centre's Notice Board as well as announced in our website: narendrapur.rkmvu.ac.in

- (3) Admission process will start immediately on announcement of the above final lists: 16 June for MSc AgBT and 17 June for MSc ARD. Selected candidates should get admitted by paying the requisite fees: Rs.17100/- (Breakup: Admission fees: Rs.5100/- + Semester fees: Rs.12000/-). Cash will be accepted only if admission is taken immediately after the list of selected candidates is announced. Those getting admitted later will have to pay the above fees by Demand Draft payable to 'Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Narendrapur (RKMVERI)', payable at Kolkata.
- (4) Last date of taking admission is 22 June 2016 (Wednesday) before 4 pm. The following two documents should be submitted at the time of admission: Medical fitness certificate from a registered medical practitioner, income certificate of parent/guardian.
- (5) Candidates of the waiting list can make enquiry on 23 June 2016 at 11 am for any vacancy. On availability of vacancy they should report for admission on 24 June 2016 at 11 am. Admission will be strictly on Merit List basis from the candidates reporting at 11 am on 24 June 2016.
- (6) Classes will start from 1st July 2016 at 9 am and all necessary instructions will be given to the students from 9 to 10 am.
- (7) **Students are expected to attend classes from the very first day and those failing to attend during the first three working days without prior permission will run the risk of cancellation of their admission.**
