(1) List of candidates finally selected for the above courses after counseling will be announced on the following dates:

(i) MSc AgBT: 16 June 2017 at 4 pm

- (ii) MSc ARD: 17 June 2017 at 4 pm
- (2) The list will be put up on the Faculty Centre's Notice Board as well as announced in our website: <u>narendrapur.rkmvu.ac.in</u> Telephonic enquiries may be made during office hours over the following phone nos: 033-24772020 / 24770232
- (3) Admission process will start from 2:00 pm of 17 June 2017(Saturday). Selected candidates should get admitted by paying the requisite fees: Rs.17,100/- (Breakup: Admission fees: Rs.5,100/- + Semester fees: Rs.12,000/-). Those getting admitted will have to pay the above fees by Demand Draft payable to 'Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Narendrapur (RKMVERI)', payable at Kolkata.
- (4) Last date of taking admission is 22 June 2017 (Thursday) up to 4 pm. (falling which they will forfeit admission).
- (5) The following three documents (along with photocopies of requisite documents if not already submitted) should be submitted at the time of admission: 1. Medical fitness certificate from a registered medical practitioner, 2. Income certificate of parent/guardian and 3. copy of Aadhaar card. Candidates should bring all requisite marksheet, certificates in original for verification.
- (6) Candidates of the waiting list can make enquiry on 23 June 2017 at 11 am for any vacancy. On availability of vacancy they should report for admission on 24 June 2017 at 11 am. Admission will be strictly on Merit List basis from the candidates reporting at 11 am on 24 June 2017.
- (7) Classes will start from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2017 at 9 am and all necessary instructions will be given to the students from 9 to 10 am.
- (8) Students are expected to attend classes from the very first day and those failing to attend during the first three working days without prior permission will run the risk of cancellation of their admission.
